- 1. Only Indian nationals are eligible to participate
- 2. Every affiliated District Chess Association / Special Unit of TNSCA is entitled to field two entries in each category.
- 3. The TNSCA General Secretary can nominate one entry.
- 4. The top four rankers from TN State Under -9 Open & Girls Chess Championship 2023 held at Erode
- 5. The top two rankers from TN State Under 7 Open &Girls Chess Championship 2023 held at Villupuram.
- 6. The host Madurai DCC (Madurai District Chess Circle) is entitled to field one additional entries.
- 7. Any players who pay the prescribed entry fee: Open & Girls Rs.1200/- may be considered for participation with recommendation of the respective District Chess Association.
- 8. In the event of odd entry, the host Madurai DCC is entitled add one more entry to make total number as even in each category.
- 9. Those who have qualified to represent the country in official FIDE events.
- 10. Any Current National Champion in any category is to be seeded to All State Championships subject to age stipulation.
- 11. In addition to above the following Districts can field additional entries by virtue of three medal winners (Gold, Silver and Bronze) secured by their players in the last TN State Under 9 Open & Girls Chess Championship 2023 held at Erode.

Boys: Gold (3) - Virudhunagar, Silver (2) - Chennai & Bronze (1) - Salem

Girls: Gold (3) - Chennai, Silver (2) - Kanyakumari & Bronze (1) - Ariyalur
